I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 12th instant, concerning No. 6640 Private A. Sloan, 20th Battalion, and in reply to state the only information available respecting his casualty is that he was wounded, as the cable received does not include the nature of his wound, nor the name of the hospital to which he was admitted.

However, his case is not specified as serious, and in the absence of further particulars, it is to be assumed he is progressing favourably, the practice of the overseas authorities being to notify the Department of any serious change in condition.
