



Dear Madam,

I have to acknowledge receipt of your communication of the 15th August relative to the grave of your son, the late Major H. Quinn, 15th Battalion, and, in response to your enquiry, to inform you that in all cases where the names of several members of the Australian Imperial Force appear on a single Cross, it is accepted as an indication that their remains are interred in the one grave.

If such is the case with the photographs recently forwarded to you, it is evident that you were misinformed when advised of the burial of the late officer in a separate grave. You will readily understand the impracticability of disinterment in single graves after such a lapse of time.

The photographs above referred to depict the latest temporary memorial erected by the Graves Registration Units pending the substitution of a permanent headstone.
