

### "Died of Wounds 8-4-18"

Re 3214 Pte.T.H.Morgan, 49th Battn. He was admitted to this C.C.S. on 6-4-18 suffering from a penetrating gun shot wound in the chest, and gun shot wounds in both arms, the left arm being fractured. He was operated on, on the 9-4-18, but died on that date. He was buried by the Rev. M.W.Cuthbert on 9-4-18. His place of burial is:— Grvae No. 20 - Row K. - Plot 1 - Communal Cemetery Extension, Gezaincourt, near Doullens.

Morgan was a farmer and had been a policeman before joining the Army. He came from the north of Ireland and was a tail, fair wan. We were at Dernicourt on April 5 and engaged in an attack when Morgan was hit by M.G. Fire, one bullet passing through his lungs, others breaking both his arms. He handed him down to the S. Bs. He was then alive, and I know nothing of his burial.
