BRIEN, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 9972. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Regiment, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, April 16, 1915; born Rowe Street, Wexford.

BRIEN, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 24876. Rank Lance-Corporal, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France April 11, 1917 (or April 6, 1917); born Killooney, Co. Galway; age 28.

BRIERLEY, EDWARD JAMES. Reg. No. 43754. Rank, Sergeant, 1st Royal Irish Rifles. killed in action, France, August 16, 1917; born Marylebone, Middlesex.

BRIERLEY, SAMUEL. Reg. No. 2241. Rank, Lance-Corporal, Royal Munster Fusiliers, 2nd Batt.; killed in action, France, July 10, 1917; born Delph, Yorkshire.

BRIGDELL, GERALD GEORGE. Reg. No. 11393. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, November 23, 1914; born Limerick.

BRIGGS, ARTHUR. Reg. No. 27734. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, March 21, 1918; born Manchester.

BRIGGS, BERTIE C. Reg. No. 4007. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Regiment, 8th Batt.; killed in action, France, September 26, 1918.

BRIGGS, HERBERT. Reg. No. G/1570. Rank, Acting Lance-Corporal, Royal Munster Fusiliers, 2 (H.S.) Garrison Batt.; died, home October 26, 1918; born Blackburn, Lancashire.

BRIGGS, JOHN. Reg. No. 200002. Rank, Regimental Quartermaster-Sergeant, 2/1 Ayrshire Yeomanry; died, home, November 17, 1917; born Castlemartyr, Co. Cork.

BRIGGS, JOHN MACKAY. Rank, Captain and Adjutant (Temporary), Royal Irish Rifles, 18th Batt.; died, October 2, 1916.

BRIGGS, LIONEL JOHN (JACK). Rank, Senior Marconi Officer, H.M.T. "Polymina"; died, 1917; age 20.

BRIGGS, THOMAS. Rank, Rifleman, attached Royal Engineers; died from wounds received in action, March 10, 1916.

BRIGGS, THOMAS. Reg. No. 7385. Rank, Rifleman, 1st Royal Irish Rifles; died of wounds, France, March 10, 1916; born Shankhill, Belfast.

BRIGGS, THOMAS HARRISON. Reg. No. 42092. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 9th Batt.; killed in action, France, October 25, 1918; born Stanwix, Cumberland.

BRIGGS, WILLIAM. Rank, Private, Royal Scots Fusiliers; died, peritonitis, hospital, Dunkerque, France, April 24, 1919.

BRIGHT, FRANK WALTER. Reg. No. 10749. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 2nd Batt.; killed in action, France, March 14, 1915; born Cheshunt, Hertfordshire.
