REMARKS.

No. 33004/18. Casual of Enquiry, held on 20 May 1918. In investigating the circumstances attending Moore's death, found that deceased was on passage between the main hatch and the combing of the hatchway of H.M.S. "Minerva", and that, upon the hatch being raised, he fell and sustained fatal injuries by striking his back against the lower steps of the ladder.

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
