 Column "EDUCATION."—State here whether he or she can "Read and Write," can "Read" only, or "Cannot Read."
 Column "SEX."—Write "M" for Males and "F" for Females.
 Column "MARRIAGE."—Whether "Married," "Widower," "Widow," or "Not Married."
 Column "WHERE BORN."—If in Ireland, state in what County or City; if elsewhere, state the name of the Country.
 Column "IRISH LANGUAGE."—Write the word "IRISH" in this column opposite the name of each person who speaks IRISH only, and the words "IRISH & ENGLISH" opposite the names of those who can speak both languages. In other cases no entry should be made in this column.
 Column "If Deaf and Dumb; Dumb only; Blind; Imbecile or idiot; or Lunatic."—Write the respective infirmities opposite the name of the afflicted person.
