Faulkner, 49th (late 9th) Battalion, and to state that beyond the bare cabled advice that he was killed in action 14.8.1916, no further details are yet available. You should receive in due course, should the stress of operations permit, a letter from either his Commanding Officer or the Regimental Chaplain, giving such facts as are known. Needless to say, anything further coming to hand in this branch will be promptly transmitted.

Personal effects when received will of course be expeditiously dealt with. Sufficient time has not yet elapsed for anything which may have been recovered to filter through the usual channels between France and Australia.

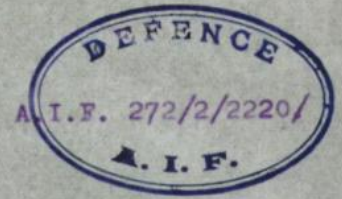
